Details about the day

The day will consist of a range of fun and exciting sporting activities throughout. All activities will be planned and delivered by trained teachers or sports coaches who currently work within educational settings on a daily basis. The key theme will be for the participants to enjoy active sports participation within a fun and pressure free environment.

Examples of the types of activities which will be delivered on a rotation throughout each day:
